This is especially true in view of a rising teaching that members of various "Churches" should not criticize their pastors and one another, but should be, as one TV preacher stated, "devoted Christians loving one another." This should be carefully considered in view of these scriptures. ψευδάδελφος (psūda-delphos) - false-brother.

## II CORINTHIANS 11 CT

26 I-have-made-and-lived-through a-night-and-day in the deep-sea; passings-of-rivers-in-the-way often, in-perils of-rivers, in-perils of robbers, in-perils out-of kindred, in-perils out-of nations, in-perils in a city, in-perils in a desert, in-perils in sea, in-perils among false-brothers,

## GALATIANS 2 CT

4 But because-of-the false-brothers sneaked-in, they-who came-in-alongside to-spy-out our freedom which we-are-having in Messiah Jesus, in-order-that they-will-thoroughly-enslave us;↓ Paul was in peril among false-brothers in his day.

## 2 Timothy 3 KJ

13 \*But evil men and seducers\* shall wax worse and worse, deceiving, and being deceived.

## II TIMOTHY 3 CT

13 But evil MEN and γόητες\* will-progress on the worse, leading-astray and being-led-astray.

If evil men and seducers were to be becoming progressively worse should we not be more on guard against "false-brothers" today? (See Apologetics #6, Misquotes)

ψευδαπόστολος - (psūdapostolos) - false-apostle.

II CORINTHIANS 11 CT

13 For the *ones* such-as-these are false-apostles, treacherous workmen, transfiguring-themselves into apostles of Messiah.

14 And no marvel, for the adversary is-transfiguring-himself into an angel of-light.

15 Therefore *it-is* not a great-thing if his ministers also are-transfiguring-themselves as ministers of-justice; of-whom the finish will-be according-to their works.

☛ The question is not; Are there false-apostles in the "church" today? The question is; How many? (See Apologetics #13, Satan, the Devil.)

ψευδολόγος - (psūdologos) - false-wording.

I TIMOTHY 4 CT

1 But the Spirit is-saying explicitly that in later seasons some will-depart of-the trust; paying-attention to-misleading spirits and to-teachings of-little-demons.

2 In hypocrisy of-false-wordings; ones having-been-and-still-branded-with-a-hot-iron on their-own conscience,

☛ False-wordings of scriptural passages are very common, and very misleading to professed believers.

ψευδοδιδάσκαλος - (psudodidas kalos) - false-teacher.

II PETER 2 CT

1 But there-became also false-prophets among the people, as also among YOU there-will-be false-teachers, they who will-introduce sects of-destruction, and denying the Despot having-bought them *in-the-market* leading-on themselves quick destruction;

2 And many will-follow-out to-the wantonnesses of-them, because of-which the way of-the truth will-be-blaphemed;

3 And in covetousness with-fabricated words they-will-merchandise YOU; for-whom the sentence from-long-ago is not being-idle, and their destruction is not becoming-drowsy.

☛ Peter warned of false-teachers with fabricated words to come to be among believers. Peter compares these false-teachers to the false-prophets among the Israelis.

ψευδοπροφήτης - (psūdopropheetes) - false-prophet.

(See the use in 2 Pet. 2:1 above under false-teacher.)

MATTHEW 7 CT

15 But YOU-be-paying-attention from the false-prophets, ones-who are-coming to YOU in clothings of-sheep, but within are seizer wolves.

16 From their fruits YOU-will-come-to-know them thoroughly.

MATTHEW 24 CT

11 And many false-prophets will-be-raised, and they-will-lead-astray many,

12 And because-of the lawlessness to-be-multiplied, the charity of-the many will-be-cooled.

24 For false-messiahs and false-prophets will be-raised, and they-will-give great signs and wonders, so-as to-lead-astray, if possible, even the chosen.

MARK 13 CT

22 For false-messiahs and false-prophets will-be-raised, and they-will-give signs and wonders, towards the to-be-leading-astray-off if possible even the chosen.

☛ Jesus himself warned of false-prophets. Note especially Matt. 24:11, 24 in Apologetics #14, #15 A 2000-YEAR PROPHECY by JESUS. (See Mark 13 also in these Apol.) "False-messiah" occurs only in Matt. 24:24 and Mark 13:22. See the fulfillment of these verses Apologetics #14, #15.

ψευδόχριστος - (psūdokristos) - false-messiah.

ψευδοπροφήτης - continued.

LUKE 6 CT

26 Woe to-YOU at-the-time-that all MEN might-say YOU well, for according-to these-things their fathers were-doing to-the false-prophets.

ACTS 13 CT

6 But having-gone-through the total island unto Paphos they-found a certain man a sorcerer, a false-prophet, a Jew, to-whom a name, Barjesus,

7 Who was together-with the proconsul Sergius Paulus, an intelligent man. This one having-called-to-himself Barnabas and Saul he-sought-after to-hear the word of-the God;

8 But Elymas the sorcerer was-withstanding-for-himself to-them, for thus his name is-being-translated-with, seeking to-twist the proconsul from the trust.

I JOHN 4 CT

1 Cherished ones, YOU-be not trusting every spirit, BUT YOU-be-proving the spirits if they-are out-of the God, because many false-prophets have-gone-out-and-still-go-out into the world.

REVELATION 16 CT

13 And I-saw out-of the mouth of-the dragon and out-of the mouth of-the beast and out-of the mouth of-the false-prophet three unclean spirits like to-frogs;

14 For they-are spirits of-little-demons, doing signs, to-be-proceeding-out over the kings of-the total inhabited-earth, to-gather them together with-reference-to the war of-the day, namely-the great day of-the God, namely-the Almighty.

REVELATION 19 CT

20 And the beast was-caught and with it the false-prophet namely-the one having-done the signs in-front of-it, with which he-led-astay the ones having-taken the mark of-the beast and the ones worshipping its image; the two were-cast living into the lake of-the fire namely-the lake being-burned with sulphur.

REVELATION 20 CT

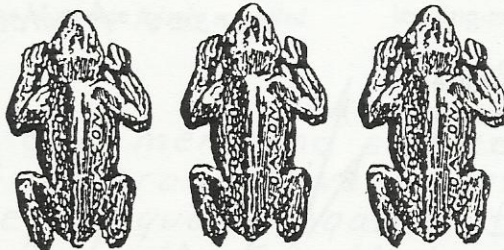
10 And the slanderer, namely-the one leading them astray, was-cast into the lake of-the fire and sulphur, where-in-which are the beast and the false-prophet, and they-will-be-tormented of-day and of-night with-reference-to the ages of-the ages.

Jesus speaks of the false-prophets in the Old Testament.  
Notice how a false-prophet seeks to-twist from the trust in the word of God.  
The reference 2 Pet.2:1 is on page 2 under "false-teacher."

John warns, by the Holy Spirit, that many false-prophets are continuously going out into the world. To assume that all "are devoted Christians loving one another" is to ignore God's warning.  
\* The next 3 uses have "THE false-  
\* prophet," but consider we are looking at figurative passages.

THE FALSE-PROPHET  
(see Apologetics # 17, Glossolalia.)

ψευδής - (psūdees) - false.

ψευδής p.4

ACTS 6 CT

13 And-additionally they stood false witnesses saying: This MAN is not ceasing speaking sayings against the place namely-this holy one and the law;

REVELATION 2 CT

1 To-the messenger of-the assembly in Ephesus you write: These-things-here the one retaining the seven stars in his right hand, the one walking-around in midst of-the seven lampstands, namely-the ones made-of-gold, is-saying:

2 I-know-absolutely your works and the labor and your perseverance, and that you-can not bear bad ones and you-tried the ones saying themselves apostles and they-are not, and you-found them false:

REVELATION 21 CT

8 But to-the timid and unbelieving and ones having-been-and-still-abominable and murderers and male-prostitutes and ones who-prepare-drugs and idolaters and to-all the ones false their part will-be in the lake namely-the one burning with-fire and with-sulphur, which is the death namely-the second.

ψευδομαρτυρία - (psūdomarturia) - false-witnessing.

MATTHEW 15 CT

19 For out-of the heart is-coming-out evil deliberations, murders, adulteries, prostitutions, thieveries, false-witnessings, blasphemies

ψευδομαρτυρ - (psūdomartur) - false-witness.

MATTHEW 26 CT

59 But the chief-priests and the elders and the total council were-seeking false-witness down-upon the Jesus, in-which-case they-might-put him to-death,

60 And they-found not: even of-many false-witnesses having-come-near they-found not.

61 But later two false-witnesses having-come-near said, This-one was-stating, I-am-being-able to-overthrow the sanctuary of-the God, and through three days to-build it up.

I CORINTHIANS 15 CT

14 But if Messiah has not been-and-is-still-raised, really, our preaching is empty, also YOUR trust is empty;

15 But also we-are-being-found false-witnesses of-the God, because we-bore-witness down-upon the God that he-raised the Messiah, whom he-raised not if-altogether dead ones are really not being-raised.

ψευδώνυμος - (psūdōnumos) - falsely-named.

I TIMOTHY 6 CT

20 O Timothy, you-guard the deposit, being-diverted-for-yourself-from the profane empty-chatters and oppositions of-the falsely-named knowledge,

21 Which some promising around the trust missed. The favor be with you.

Note in this passage KJ has "liars", which should be "false". That is, they were found to be false-apostles.

(see ψεύστης - psūstees)

In this passage also the word is "false".

These are false-teachers, false-prophets, false-apostles etc.

We certainly are warned against false leaders in these days.

Not "liars" as in KJ

The next use of this word, Matt. 26:59, see the next word below.

Conclusion: The "church" is not composed of, "devoted Christians loving one another," (p.1) but rather false-teachers, false-apostles, false-witnesses, false-prophets etc. Review page 2 especially.

Falsely-named knowledge crept into the "church" at an early date.
