Arist., Philo, Joseph., Test. 12 Patr.) used to designate the custom of prostrating oneself before a person and kissing his feet, the hem of his garment, the ground, etc.; the Persians did this in the presence of their deified king, and the Greeks before a divinity or someth. holy; (fall down and) worship, do obeisance to, prostrate oneself before, do reverence to, welcome respectfully, in Attic Gk.

I have underlined 15 lines, in the Concordance lines. that clearly illustrate this meaning. Note that this verb only occurs once in a church letter.

Bowing in worship, "demands visible majesty before which the worshipper bows." See the Theological Dictionary of the New Testament, Vol. 6, p. 765. There are no instructions in "church" letters for "Christians" to worship. KJ uses worship" for several Greek words; all incorrectly.
