1. The name Israel was first given to Jacob. Gen. 32.28 See our tract, "Israel's Origin."

2. Jacob's 12 sons were the 12 tribes of Israel. Gen. 49.28

3.Ephraim and Manasseh, the two sons of Joseph, added two tribes replacing Joseph's tribe. Num. 1.33,35

4.This made a total of 13 tribés, of which God took Levi. Num. 8.14

8. Invading armies took many prisoners from both Judah and Israel into captivity. In 722B.C. Israel went into final captivity. In 586 B.C. Judah followed Israel into captivity. It was in this period the term **Jew** began.

Summary-

a-Thousands from Israel moved to Judah; note the army growth.

b-Only the best were taken into exile. 2 Kings 24.14; 25.12

c-Israel finally had only parts of 9 tribes, not 10.

The term Jew (from Judah) was applied to any of the exiles as it was impossible to know the tribe.

Mordecai a Jew, a Benjamite.
