
### DISCOURSE 3 TWO PASSOVERS

And this ought to be done for the honor of God and of Christianity in order that God may see that we are Christians, and that we have not wittingly tolerated or approved of such public lying, cursing, and blaspheming of His Son and His Christians . . . Secondly, their homes should likewise be broken down and destroyed. For they perpetrate the same things there that they do in their synagogues. For this reason they ought to be put under one roof or in a stable, like gypsics, in order that they may realize that they are not masters in our land, as they boast, but miserable captives, as they complain of us incessantly before God with bitter wailing. § Thirdly, they should be deprived of their prayerbooks and Talmuds in which such idolatry, lies, cursing, and blasphemy are taught. § Fourthly, their rabbis must be forbidden under threat of death to teach any more ... "Fifthly, passport and traveling privileges should be absolutely forbidden to the Jews. For they have no business in the rural districts since they are not nobles, nor officials, nor merchants, nor the like. Let them stay at home. . Vol. 7 14th edition There is no indication of the observance of the Easter festival in the New Testament, or in the writings of the apostolic Fathers. The sanctity of special times was an idea absent from the minds of the first Christians, who continued to observe the Jewish festivals, though in a new spirit, as commemorations of events which those festivals had foreshadowed. Thus the Passover, with a new conception added to it of Christ as the true Paschal Lamb and the first fruits from the dead, continued to be observed, and became the Christian Easter.







ELIJAH TAKEN UP TO HEAVEN IN A CHARIOT OF FIRE

Behold, there appeared a chariot of fire, and horses of fire, and parted them both asunder; and Elijah went up by a whirlwind into heaven. And Elisha saw it, and he cried, My father, my father, the chariot of Israel, and the horsemen thereof. And he saw him no more . . . (Il Kings 2: 11, 12)

In this drawing by Doré, Elijahthe prophet is taken 13 into heaven. Read the whole account in I Kings, Dore was, to my mind, the greatest of Bible illustrators.

DORÉ, PAUL GUSTAVE, (1832-1883), French artist, the son of a civil engineer, was born at Strasbourg on Jan. 6, 1832, and died in Paris on Jan. 23, 1883. In 1848 he came to Paris and secured a three years' engagement on the Journal pour rire. His facility as a draughtsman was extraordinary, and among the books he illustrated in rapid succession were Balzac's Contes drolatiques (1855), Dante's Inferno (1861), Don Quixote (1863), The Bible (1865), Paradise Lost (1866), the Fables of La Fontaine (1867), and the works of Rabelais (1873). He painted also many large and ambitious compositions of a religious or historical character, and had some success as a sculptor. Doré's illustrations had a great popular success over a long period of years, especially in England and America. See W. B. Jerrold, Life of Gustave Doré (1891).






