2. The Tabernacle (25:1-27:21)

Biblical interpretation passed through an era of extreme typological and Christological emphases in which the tabernacle was interpreted almost exclusively as a type of Christ. That there were legitimate principles concerning the nature of God inherent within the structure of the tabernacle, as well as the priest's dress and functions, is gladly recognized. One should, however, be exceedingly cautious not to tear the Scripture from its historical and theological context, and force it to serve an end for which it was never intended. \*

6. The Glory of God Fills the Tabernacle

As though to place a stamp of divine approval upon the work of Moses and his people, the glory of God filled the tabernacle, not only assuring Israel of the Lord's continuing presence, but guaranteeing them that the Lord approved of what had been done. The experience is, of course, closely paralleled by the glory of God filling the Temple in the Solomonic era (cf. 1 Kings 8:11).

By the time the present narrative was written, Israel had come to understand the cloud as an unusual phenomenon which at times filled the tabernacle and on other occasions rose above the tent. When the cloud settled in and around the tent, Israel remained at rest from her journeying, but she moved forward when the cloud rose over the tabernacle. In addition, fire was in it by night, probably symbolizing the glory of God, his burning, fiery presence.

5. The Completion and Erection of the Tabernacle (39:32-40:33)

Vol. 1 p.455 Broadman Commentary I regret having to use so much space to display this writer's "disbelief" of God's word and at the same time his stupidity. I could ask for no better way however to illustrate one of Satan's ministers working within the "church.

The Jews have patiently copied the OT scriptures by hand, with almost perfect accuracy. #### The New Testament Text

There is more manuscript support for the New Testament than for any other body of ancient literature. Over five thousand Greek, eight thousand Latin, and many more manuscripts in other languages attest the integrity of the New Testament. There is only one basic New Testament used by Protestants, Roman Catholics, and Orthodox, by conservatives and liberals. Minor variations in hand copying have appeared through the centuries, before mechanical printing began in A.D. 1450. Some variations exist in the spelling

of Greek words, in word order, and in similar details. These ordinarily do not show up in translation and do not affect the sense of the text in any way.

Other manuscript differences, regarding the omission or inclusion of a word or a clause, and two paragraphs in the gospels, should not overshadow the overwhelming degree of agreement which exists among the ancient records. Bible readers may be assured that the most important differences in the English New Testament of today are due, not to manuscript divergence, but to the way in which translators view the task of translation: How literally should the text be rendered? How does the translator view the matter of biblical inspiration? Does the translator adopt a paraphrase when a literal rendering would be quite clear and more to the point?

"Hear, O Israel, Jehovah our Gods is Jehovah a unity" (Deut. 6:4, lit. trans.). אֵלְהִינוּ, 'elohēnu, as we shall see, is plural and literally means "our Gods." But the statement affirms that, though there is a plurality of divine personalities constituting the Supreme Being, they are in a real and unique sense a unity. So long, therefore, as words have definite meanings and language a set syntax, this Great Confession of Israel cannot be twisted to mean anything different from what it states plainly in the accurate translation given above—if it is studied and analyzed in accordance with scientific principles. For this and other reasons, that time does not permit my giving, I assert that Elohim primarily and usually refers to the three divine personalities constituting the Supreme Being. One cannot therefore read a singular meaning into this word unless the facts of a certain context indicate a departure from the literal meaning and demand a secondary or a metaphorical definition.

much is a warning to Satan. No wonder Satan"blasphemes" God's name (\*) and the tabernacle (Rev. 13:6 p. 5).

Satan also "blasphemes" "the (ones) tabernacling in the heavens. (Rev. 13:6) I believe he "blasphemes" these because these are forever out of Satan' reach and the river which he cast out of his mouth to reach them, failed.

Satan knew who Jesus was when they met face to face in the 6 trials of Jesus. When Satan could not persuade Jesus to serve him, Satan next tried to keep Jesus from the cross. 




