ἀπείθεια.

That this noun, with ἀπειθέω and ἀπειθής, connotes invariably "disobedience, rebellion, contumacy," is made abundantly clear from papyri and inscriptions: Grimm's assumption that ἀπειθέω (instead of ἀπιστέω) is the antithesis to πιστεύω, though supported by the RV mg (= ΛV) in In 3⁸⁶, has no warrant whatever.

When the kJ was revised in 1982 all uses of the noun were corrected to, "disobedience." All uses of the adjective remained, "disobedient."

However the verbs in John 3:36, (see MM above)
Acts 14:2, Acts 19:9, Rom. 15:31, and Heb. 11:31 were left as is, while Rom. 11:30,31, and Heb. 3:18 were corrected. Strangely enough Acts 17:5 was changed to "--- who were not persuaded."

Note in Eph. 5:6" the wrath of the God iscoming", present tense. (see also Rom. 1)

The similar phrase occurs in Col. 3:6; that is, "is-coming". The verb "is-coming" is present active indicative, not future.

Heb. 4:6,11 shows that because of Israel's disobedience they did not then enter into God's rest. A punishment, present in their time.

I do not see any reason why Eph. 5:6 and Col. 3:6 should not refer to God's present wrath being visited upon the evils mentioned.

John 3:36 bears this
out. This verse was
spoken before the cross.
Notice in Matt. 4:17 Jesus
said, "Repent ye; for
the kingdom of heaven
is at hand." Therefore;
"the (one) disobeying tothe son will not see
life, BUT the wrath
of-the God is-remaining on him." Doctrine
is affected by the
change in John 3:36.

There is a problem in the Greek text in / Acts 17:5. The KJ Greek text (Receptus) has the verb in; while ABX etc. (Nestle) text, omits the word.

EPHESIANS 5 CT

5 For this YOU-are coming-to-know, that every male-prostitute or unclean *man* or covetous *man*, who-is *an* idolater, he-is not having inheritance in the kingdom of-the Messiah and God.

There is a present wrath of God as on p.2, and a future wrath as. Well. "But according to your hardness and unrepentant heart you-are storing for yourself wrath in (a) day of wrath ---(God) who will-give-back to-each (one) according-to his works." (Rom. 2:5,6) Now Rom. 2:7,8 above. Heb. 11:31 - "the (ones) having-disobeyed ---The inhabitants of Jericho knew that God gave Israel the land and they should have received Israel in peace, as did Rahab. (See Hebrews Commentary, and Joshua 2:8-11) In reference to the verb "disobey", keep in mind that I Peter is written to Jewish believers. Therefore the disobeying Jews are the ones stumbling at the word. (1 Pet. 2:8) 1 Pet. 3:1 The Sewish husband might be in this number. 1 Pet. 3:20 refers to persons in the time of Noah. 1 Pet. 4:17 probably refers to disobeying Jews, see vs. 18 for the

Gentiles.

ROMANS 2 CT



In Titus 3:3 and Titus 1:16 "disobedient" to their inherent Knowledge of what God calls good. Adam and Eve got this Knowledge by eating of the fruit and so passed it on to the entire race. Thus man is responsible.

3 For we ourselves were also at-one-time thoughtless, disobedient, being-led-astray, being-slaves to-various desires and pleasures, leading-through-out in malice and envy, abhorrent, hating one-another.

4 But when the graciousness and the love-of-mankind
