The KJ usually confuses this word with oikia (oikia), "house" or "family." (See the "control word" oikia.) The KJ translates oikos by "house" 102x, "home" 4x, "household" 3x, and "temple" Ix; so I have not listed the KJ concordance phrases but rather the Consistent New Testament phrases.

The stars (\*) indicate an unusual use of "home", while the circles ( ) indicate God's "home" 1.In Matt. 12:44, and Luke 11:24 it is the "home" of evil spirits; a man's body. 2. The passages: Luke 1:27, household of David; Luke 1:33. "household of Jacob; Luke 1:69, household of David; Luke 2:4. "household of-David all have connection with the lineage of the Messiah. 3 Matt. 23:38 and Luke 13:35 "Your home" probably refers to the temple, once God's home, now Israel's; or to Jerusalem itself. 

In the book to the Hebrews God refers to the household of Israel (the northern Kingdom), and "the household of Judah" (the southern Kingdom). (vs.8) (vs.9) - God led them all out of Egypt. (vs. 10) - "the household of Israel" as one nation, as they are to day.

In considering the phrase "(a) spiritual house-hold", read I Pet. 1:1. (below) I Peter is written to Jews who believe in Jesus as the Messiah. It is they specifically who are being built (a) spiritual household."




