We need not show the uses in the KJ, as this word is translated "Knowledge" with only one exception, 17im. 6:20. We will consider the KJ translation of 1 Tim. 6:20 later. See also the "control word" Estivuwois (epignosis), 'thorough-knowledge" (Marked ., when occurring in this study.) The first use in the NT concerns the purpose of John the Baptist's coming: "to-give Knowledge-of-Salvation, K to God's people, the Israelis.

## LUKE 1 CT

76 But you, pre-teen-child, will-be-called a prophet of-the-Most-High; for you-will-proceed-before, before the person of-Jehovah to-prepare his ways;

77 To-give knowledge of-salvation to his people with forgiveness of-their sins,

#### LUKE 11 CT

52 Woe to-YOU the lawyers, because YOU-removed the key of-the knowledge; YOU yourselves went not in, and the-ones going-in YOU-hindered.

Matt. ver. 14, which words are the best explanation of our text:-the key of knowledge (i. e. not of, as admitting to, knowledge—but the key is the knowledge), being that right understanding of the Law and Prophets, which should shew Him to the people, of whom they testified; this the expounders of Scripture had taken away, neither themselves entering, nor permitting those to enter who were otherwise doing so, -and thus shutting the kingdom of heaven in men's faces.

This is the only other use in the gospels. This is again referring to Bible Knowledge." (See Alford)

This "Knowledge" is "Bible

Knowledge"; giving proof of

Who Jesus was, (Matt. 3:3 etc.)

Next consider a passage to Jewish Christians. It was the Jewish father who was responsible for "knowledge" of scripture, 1 Peter 3:7

### I PETER 3 CT

6 As Sara obeyed the Abraham, calling him lord; of-whom YOU-became children doing-good and not fearing notone terror.

7 The husbands likewise, dwelling-together according-to knowledge as with-a-weaker vessel the one of-a-woman, bestowing honor as also to-heirs-together, of-favor of-life, with-reference-to YOUR prayers not to-be-impeded.

> All the 3 uses of the word in Romans refer to Bible Knowledge. Remember these references to "Bible Knowledge" mean the OT, the NT did not yet exist.

The depth of God's riches and wisdom and knowledge are only learned from the study of scripture. (Rom. 11: 33

Remember the article "the" acts as a pointer ; in these passages pointing to "the Knowledge" given in the OT. YVWOCS-P.2 II PETER 1 CT

5 But also *for* this very *thing* having-brought-in-alongside all diligence, YOU-supply-additional in YOUR trust the virtue, but in the virtue the knowledge,

6 But in the knowledge the self-control; but in the self-control the perseverance; but in the perseverance the

piety;

7 But in the piety the brotherly-love; but in the brotherly-

love the charity.

8 For these *things* existing and abounding in-YOU [is] are-establishing you not idle nor without-fruit with-reference-to the thorough-knowledge of our Lord Jesus Messiah;

II PETER 3 CT

14 On-this-account, cherished *ones*, anticipating these-things YOU-be-diligent to-be-found by-him in peace ones-without-spot and without-blemish,

15 And YOU-be-considering the patience of our Lord: salvation, according-as also our cherished brother Paul wrote to-YOU according-to the wisdom having-been-given to-him,

16 As also <u>in all epistles</u> speaking in them concerning these-things, <u>in which epistles</u> [is] <u>are some-things difficult-to-understand</u>, which the unlearned and unsteady are-distorting as also the other scriptures toward their own

destruction.

17 YOU therefore, cherished *ones*, coming-to-know-before YOU-be-guarding-yourselves in-order-that having-been-led-away-together by-the going-astray of-the unruly YOU-might not fall-away *from* your own firm-fixedness, 18 But YOU-be-growing in favor and knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Messiah. To-him the glory also now and with-reference-to a day of-an-age.

## **EPHESIANS 3 CT**

19 And-additionally to-know the charity of-the Messiah surpassing [the] knowledge, in-order-that YOU-might-be-filled with-reference-to all the fulness of-the God.

### PHILIPPIANS 3 CT

8 BUT yea-therefore I-am also considering all *things* to-be a disadvantage on-account-of the holding-above of-the knowledge of-Messiah Jesus my Lord, on-account-of whom I-was-disadvantaged by all the *things*, and I-am-considering them refuse[s] in-order-that I-might-gain Messiah,

COLOSSIANS 2 CT

2 In-order-that their hearts might-be-comforted, having-been-brought-to-agreement in charity and with-reference-to all riches of-the certainty of-the intelligence, with-reference-to-thorough-knowledge of-the mystery of-the God, of-Messiah.

3 In whom all the stores of-the wisdom and knowledge are

hidden-back.

4 This I-am-saying in-order-that no-one might-be-cheating YOU in-reckoning with persuasive-speech.

I believe "the knowledge" is that knowledge gained from scripture which alone will lead to "the thorough-knowledge" of the Lord Jesus. (vs. 8)

Peter in his last use of the word "Knowledge" gives La warning that indicates it must be a "Biblical Knowledge." 1. He refers to Paul having Written. 2. All epistles are having difficult things. 3. The unlearned and unsteady are distorting these things, as also the other scriptures. (OT) 4. Peter warns about the danger of falling away from firm-fixedness. 5. To offset this a person must be growing in favor and Knowledge". Only Biblical Knowledge" will teach concerning Jesus Messiah.

Messiah for the believers surpasses the Knowledge. Because of the article, I believe this also to refer to Biblical Knowledge; which seems to be confirmed by Phil. 3:8. The true Knowledge of the Messiah; that is, his plan and purpose for the world is contained in the Bible.

Note "thorough-Knowledge".

All the stores "of-the wisdom and (the) Knowledge" are in the Messiah, "Biblical-Knowledge".

### I CORINTHIANS 13 CT

2 And if <u>I-might-be-having prophecy and I-might-know-absolutely all the mysteries and all the knowledge</u>, and if I-might-be-having all the trust so-as to-be-shifting mountains, but I-might not be-having charity, I-am nothing.

## II CORINTHIANS 2 CT

14 But favor to-the God to-the *one* always triumphing us in the Messiah and manifesting the smell of-the knowledge of-him through us in every place;

15 Because we-are a fragrance of-Messiah to-the God among the *ones* being-saved and among the *ones* perishing.

# II CORINTHIANS 4 CT

6 Because the God *namely*-the *one* having said: Out-of darkness light will-shine, who shined in our hearts toward enlightenment of-the knowledge of-the glory of-the God in *the* person of-Messiah.

### II CORINTHIANS 10 CT

5 Lowering figurings and every high-thing elevating-itself against the knowledge of-the God, and leading-captive every thought with-reference-to the obedience of-the Messiah,

## II CORINTHIANS 11 CT

6 If on-the-other-hand *I-am* also a layman in-the word, BUT not in-the knowledge. BUT in every thing having-been-manifested in all-things with-reference-to YOU.

#### I CORINTHIANS 8 CT

6 BUT to-us one God the Father, out-of whom *are* the all-things and we with-reference-to him, and one Jehovah Jesus Messiah, through whom *are* the all-things and we through him.

7BUT the knowledge is not in all; but some in-the customtogether of-the idol till just-now they-are-eating as an idolatrous-sacrifice, and their conscience being weak isbeing-soiled.

8 But food will not stand us alongside with-the God; for neither if we-might-eat are-we-having-an-advantage; nor if we-might not eat are-we-lacking-for-ourselves.

9 But YOU-be-looking lest-perchance this authority of-YOU might-become stumbling to-the weak *ones*.

#### I CORINTHIANS 8 CT

1 But concerning the idolatrous-sacrifices, we-are-knowing-absolutely that we all are-having knowledge. The knowledge is-inflating, but the charity is-building-up.

Paul certainly refers to all "Biblical Knowledge". In 2 Cor. 2:14 "the Knowledge" of the Messiah can hardly be other than what we know from scripture. This certainly also is true of "the Knowledge" of the glory of the God. (2C.4:6) The Knowledge" of the God which we have must be from scripture. (2 Cor. 10:5)

In 2 Cor. 11:6 Paul had revealed "Knowledge" as well as "the Knowledge of the O.T. (See Eph. 3:1-13) Thus the N.T. also becomes part of "the Knowledge" which we have available.

By having all passages together I believe we can study this word "Knowledge" and come to an interesting conclusion. It seems that "the knowledge" refers, with the article"the", to a specific part of the "Biblical Knowledge." Here in I Cor. 8:7 "the Knowledge" is that "Biblical Knowledge" regarding idols. Some have "Bible knowledge," (vs. 10,11), on this subject. Then 161.8:1; all believers have Bible Knowledge, at least in part, but "the (Bible) Knowledge, on the subject of idols, can inflate the person's eqo to a point, where "the charity" towards the weaker brother is overlooked. (I Cor. 8:10)

See the twisting, "false-wordings", and adulterating of the word of God in Apologetics 6. \* We see false teachers "twisting", "(a) word of knowledge in 1 Cor. 12:8 to mean a word that someone in the audience has some particular need; instead of imparting a word of Knowledge, that is some truth from scripture as Paul did.
