Let me call your attention to two words, nearly alike in meaning. Both words are translated "genesis" in the CT. The noun YEVEOUS (genesis) is the name used in the LXX for The Book of Genesis. The NT passages; Matt. 1:1, Luke 1:14, James 1:23, and James 3:6 should all be listed under this noun. This noun comes from the verb xivouas (ginomai) meaning "to-come-to-be" hence "genesis" On the other hand, the noun YÉVYNOIS (genneesis) comes from the verb yervaw (gennao) in Matt. 1:18 from this verb translated "to-beget," (See this Dict.)

the Holy Spirit to mark a slight distinction between the yévvnois of our Lord and that of ordinary men.

Here also we have the meaning "genesis" but only
Alford's Greek in connection with "the genesis ofthe Jesus Messiah." (CT) Note Alford's comment. Remember Jesus was begotten by the Father. (See YEVVáw (gennao) page 3 especially.)

This is the only verse using xénunois. The Messiah always was; he did not "come to be."

4 references to "Products of-vipers." The only other use of viper in the NT is Acts 28:3 referring to a real viper.

Of the 4 uses here 2 are by John the Baptist and 2 by

Jesus. Those to whom John and Jesus spoke were not called a "generation of vipers" as in KJ, but "Products of vipers" or "offspring of vipers" as in ASV. "Vipers" is used in a figurative sense referring to cunning, malignant, wicked men. (See Thayer's Lexicon) It is the fathers that are refer-

## MATTHEW 11 CT

#### LUKE 7 CT

Z Other translations have "born of women" which would make John greater than Jesus. The Greek yuvn (qunee) is "wife" or "woman". "Born of-wives" eliminates this difficulty.
