When this passage is translated more accurately it likens Paul to a priest in the temple; and the "good-news" the light of the lampstand. (See also Heb. 8:2) Paul wrote by the Holy Spirit to the "church" at Rome (1), Corinth (2), Galatia (3), Ephesus (4), Philippi (5), Colossae (6), and Thessalonica (7); exactly the 7 branches of the lampstand.
