

File under: vaos or naos English: "sanctuary"

This word should not be confused with <u>ispor</u> (hieron), "temple". See temple under the control-word <u>ispos</u> (hieros). The <u>vaos</u>, "sanctuary" consists of the <u>Holy of Holies</u> and the



Holy Place only. Temple, includes the whole structure, including all the court or courts.

Unfortunately the KJ translates both words alike: Vaos, "temple" 45x; LEPÓV, "temple" 71x.

MATTHEW 23 CT

16 Woe to-YOU blind leaders-of-the-way, the-ones saying, Whosoever might-swear in the sanctuary, it-is nothing; but whosoever might-swear in the gold of-the sanctuary, he-is-being-indebted.

17 Stupid-ones and blind, for which is greater, the gold, or the sanctuary, namely-the-one making the gold holy?

18 And, Whosoever might-swear in the altar, it-is nothing; but whosoever might-swear in the gift, *namely*-the-one above-upon it, he-is-being-indebted.

19 Stupid-ones and blind, for what is greater, the gift, or the altar, namely-the-one making the gift holy?

20 Therefore the one having-sworn in the altar he-is-swearing in it and in all-things the ones above-upon it.

21 And the-one having-sworn in the sanctuary he-is-swearing in it and in the-one residing-in it.

22 And the-one having-sworn in the heaven he-is-swearing in the throne of-the God and in the-one sitting above-upon it.

MATTHEW 23 CT

35 In-which-case all just blood being-shed upon the earth might-come upon YOU, from the blood of-Abel the just; till the blood of-Zacharias son of-Barachias, whom YOU-murdered between the sanctuary and the altar.

LUKE 11 CT

50 In-order-that the blood of-all of-the prophets namely-the blood being-poured-out from a casting-down of-a-world might-be-sought-out from this generation, 51 From the blood of-Abel till the blood of-Zacharias, of-the one having-perished between the altar and the home; yea, I-am-saying to-YOU, it-will-be-sought-out from this generation.

These verses refer to the <u>"Sanctuary"</u> in Herod's temple, * Matt. 23:35 is a very interesting verse. Note the connection with Luke 11:51 where the <u>"Sanctuary"</u> is called God's "home."

20 'And the Spirit of God came upon Zechariah the son of Jehoiada the priest; and he stood above the people, and said unto them, Thus saith God, 'Why transgress ye the commandments of Jehovah, so that ye cannot prosper?' because ye have forsaken Jehovah, he hath also forsaken you. 21 And 'they conspired against him, and stoned him with stones at the commandment of the king in the court of the house of Jehovah. 22 Thus Joash the king remembered not the kindness which Jehoiada his father had done to him, but slew his son. And when he died, he said, 'Jehovah look upon it, and require it.

Zacharias' father was Jehoiada. Jesus appears to have called Jehoiada, Barachias. (See John Lightfoots long comment on this, Vol. 2, pp. 302-308)

It may be that "son of Barachias" was not spoken by Jesus, but added from Zech. 1:1 by mistake later? (It is a problem.)

LUKE 1 CT

9 According-to the custom of-the priest's-office, he-procured-by-destiny to-burn-incense, having-gone-in into the sanctuary of-the Lord.

21 And the people were anticipating the Zacharias, and they-were-marvelling with his to-be-lingering in the sanc-

tuary.

22 But having-come-out he-was not being-able to-speak to-them, and they-came-to-know-thoroughly that he-hadseen a supernatural-appearing in the sanctuary. And he himself was constantly-nodding to-them, and he-was-remaining-continuously dull.

JOHN 2 CT

19 The Jesus answered and said to-them, YOU-breakdown this sanctuary, and in three days I-shall-raise it.

20 The Jews therefore said, In forty and six years this sanctuary was-built, and you yourself-will-raise it in three

21 But that one was-saying concerning the sanctuary of-his

body.

This statement made by Jesus was still an issue while Jesus was on the cross. >

MATTHEW 27 CT

40 And saying: The one overthrowing the sanctuary and building-up in three days, you-save-yourself, if you-are son of-the God, and you-descend from the cross.

MARK 15 CT

29 And the ones proceeding-along were-blaspheming him moving their heads and saying: Aha the one overthrowing the sanctuary and in three days building-up.

30 You-save yourself, and you-descend from the cross.

MATTHEW 27 CT 🛠

50 But the Jesus having-cried again with-a-great voice he-let-go the spirit.

Zacharias receives the anouncement from an angel of the Lord that he is to have a son to be named John.

Note Jesus' statement concerning the sanctuary of his body. Consider how the Jews understood Jesus, and note the difference of the witnesses.

MATTHEW 26 CT

61 But later two false-witnesses having-come-near said, This-one was-stating, I-am-being-able to-overthrow the sanctuary of-the God, and through three days to-build it

MARK 14 CT

58 That we ourselves-heard as he was saying, that I myselfshall-overthrow this sanctuary namely-the one made-byhand, and through three days I-shall-build-up another not-made-by-hand. 59 And neither thus was their witness equal.

Judas Iscariot cast the 30 pieces of silver into the sanctuary. Matt. 27:5

MATTHEW 27 CT

4 Saying, I-sinned having-given-over innocent blood. But the-ones said, What is-it to us? You yourself-will-see. 5 And having-thrown the silver-coins in the sanctuary he-retired, and having-gone-away he-hanged-himself.

* There are 3 records of the fact that the yeil of the sanctuary, between the Holy of Holies and Holy Place, was rent exactly when Jesus died. To prove this, the Holy Spirit records the rending after Jesus released the spirit, in Matt. 27:51 and Mark 15:38. But hefore Jesus released the spirit, in Luke 23:45. How could the rending be placed more exactly?

ACTS 19 CT

24 For a certain Demetrius by-name, a silver-smith, making silver sanctuaries of-Artemis he-is-himself-holdingbeside for-the craftsmen no little-bit business;

Acts 7:48 The word "sanctuary" in this verse, is in the KJ, translated temple; but vaos is not in the Nestle text given here. >

47 But Solomon built-up a home for-him. 48 BUT the Most High is not residing within ones madeby-hand; according-as the prophet is-saying:

ACTS 17 CT

24 The God namely-the one having-made the world and all the-things in it, this-one existing Jehovah of-heaven and of-earth is not residing in sanctuaries made-by-hand,

16 Are-YOU not knowing-absolutely that YOU-are the sanctuary of-God and the Spirit of-the God is-dwelling in YOU?



This picture will give you some idea of what a "silver Sanctuary of Artemis (Diana) might be like.

That is: God is not residing permanently in a fixed sanctuary like idols do; God cannot be limited.

* We come now to the use of "sanctuary" in Paul's letters to the "churches" Seven of these indicate that the true believers are God's "sanctuary"

* I CORINTHIANS 6 CT

18 YOU-be-fleeing the prostitution. Every sinful-act which if a MAN might-do is outside the body; but the one committing-prostitution is-sinning with-reference-to his

own body.

F EPHESIANS 2 CT

REVELATION 3 CT

I take this word "sanctuary" to refer to God's dwelling place in the believers (vaós-p.3)

The Greek word for "pillar" is otivos (stulos). The LXX uses the same word for the "boards" and "pillars" of the tabernacle, (vaós-p.1) which is a parable.

Sanctuary in this passage refers to the tabernacle in heaven. The great tribulation has been going on for the last 1950 years.

L believe "sanctuary" in this passage refers to EzeKiel's temple, still to be built. (Ezk. 40-48)

* I find eleven references
to the "sanctuary" of the
tabernacle in heaven. This
is the original tabernacle
shown to Moses. Israel's
tabernacle in the wilderness
was constructed according
to this pattern. Heavenly
activity took place in and
around this structure. So
also Israel's activity was
around the earthly tabernacle in which God's presence
dwelt. (See Apologetics 8)


