This is a very easy word to translate into English. The KJ translates this word by the English "throne" 54x and regrettably by "seat" 7x. (Luke 1:52; Rev. 2:13; Rev. 4:4,4; Rev. 11:16; Rev. 13:2; Rev. 16:10) I have put this word into the dictionary to help give a summary of a very important subject. The LXX uses

(thronos), "throne" more than 100x, but the first use in the NT is by Sesus. Heaven is God's throne. Jesus in speaking refers to the Father.

The Messiah Jesus who is also Jehovah is the image of the Father and the one through whom all "throne- are created.

their crowns in-sight of-the throne, saying:

11 You-are worthy, the Lord and the God of-us, to-take the glory and the honor and the power, because you yourself created the all things and because-of your will they-were and they-were-created.

"in right of-the throne", not at or on (ask) which indicates a physical throne.

Ecclesiastes 10 ASV wise man's heart is at his right hand; but a fool's heart at his

Since heaven is God's throne (Mat. 5:34 above), Jesus is seated in the right (side) having been obedient to the Father. See also Matt. 25: 33,41. Here we have a physical "throne" and the only personality of the trinity that has a physical form is Jesus; but remember Jesus is Jehovah. We have 24 elders sitting on 24 thrones. There are 7 torches burning in sight of the throne. Note also 4 living-creatures.

Only the son can sit on the "throne". But Jesus' explanation in John 14 is necessary for our understanding.



JOHN 14 CT

7 If YOU-had-come-to-know me, YOU-had-come-toknow my Father also; and from just-now YOU-are-coming-to-know him, and YOU-have-seen-and-are-still-seeing him.

8 Philip is-saying to-him, Lord, You-point-out the Father

to-us, and it-is-sufficing for-us.

9 The Jesus is-saying to-him, I-am this-much time with YOU, and you-have not come-to-know-or-still-know me, Philip? The one having-seen me, he-has-seen-and-still-sees the Father; and how are-you yourself saying, Youpoint-out the Father to-us?





"The government of the pontiff," says Rev. Dr. Wylie, "is a theocracy. Let the reader try to understand what this imports as applied to the papal states. The pontifical government is not the government of a mere man, or of a human code; it is the government of God himself—God in the person of his vicar. It is, or professes to be, as real a theocracy as that which was set up in Judea of old. . . . But while the Old Testament, the representative of Jehovah, the real monarch of the Jewish kingdom, limited the prerogative of the prince, and defined the rights of his subjects, it is otherwise with the ruler of the papal states. He 'as God' sitteth in the midst of his kingdom, ruling it according to his own irresponsible will. He is the maker of his own law; and that law neither sets limits to his powers nor grants rights to his subjects. He exercises, in measure altogether absolute and unbounded, both the temporal and the spiritual authority.

The Roman Catholic church is no absurd and meaningless bugbear, but a living and active organism, formidable in its strength and efficiency. Those who know little of its power may make themselves merry over its pretensions; but many a Protestant can echo the sentiment uttered by the late Rev. Richard Cecil of the Church of England:

And strongly does Dr. Cumming enforce this idea:



Despise it, it will overwhelm you; tamper with it, it will ensuare and captive you; resist it in the name of God, and like its author the Devil, it will instantly flee from you. It is the masterpiece of Satan beyond dispute, and only by viewing it in that light will you be enabled rightly to estimate your danger and its inherent element of progress and power."
