This word also is used compounded with prepositions. First: can this verb always be translated by, "to-appear"?

KJ uses appear seen, think, shine, seem. These translations might be satisfactory in ordinary works but we are talking about the

word of God. To shift from one word to another may alter what God means.



There is no need for KJ Changing Mark 14:64 or Luke 24:11

John 1 KJ

5 And the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it.

I believe "shines" changes the entire meaning of the verse.

John 12 KJ

46 "I have come as a light into the world, that whoever believes in Me should not abide in darkness.

Not the shining but his presence is the concern.

John 5 KJ (1982)

35 "He was the burning and shining lamp, and you were willing for a time to rejoice in his light.

same throughout. Phil. 2:15, the believers appear as light-givers, is better than believers shine! In 2Pet.1, the prophetic word appears; as a lamp might suddenly appear if you were in a dark place. In 1 John 2:8 the authentic light, Jesus, is appearing, why shining? When we come to the compounds of this word it will be even more clear why words should not be changed by translators.
