This word is of primary importance in, any study of the resurrection. See the "control word" aviotnul -(anisteemi) with which excip w - (egeiro) is badiy confused in the KJ translation. Also refer to Chronology II, pages A-23 - A-30. We will also consider the feminine noun EYEPOLS - (egersis) which should be properly translated by resurrection. This noun only occurs once.

On page 3 we have an interesting figurative use in John 2, indicated by . Jesus uses the sanctuary of the temple, as the Jews thought, as figurative of the sanctuary of his body.
