Under this "control-word" we will also consider the neuter noun kalumma (Kalumma) covering. The noun occurs only 4 times and all 4 in the same passage. It is necessary to read Ex. 34:33-35 to properly understand the N.T. passage. I have used covering for the noun, to agree

with the verb "to-cover". The word "veil" can imply an attempt to hide, which is not the case. Note Ex. 34:35, they "saw the face of Moses". In 2 Cor. 3 there is no intent to "hide" or "conceal". Verse 15 "(a) covering is on their heart," not "hearts".

Exodus 34 ASV

33 And when Moses had done speaking with them, he put a veil on his face. 34 But when Moses went in before Jehovah to speak with him, he took the veil off, until he came out; and he came out, and spake unto the children of Israel that which he was commanded. 35 And the children of Israel saw the face of Moses, that the skin of Moses' face shone: and Moses put the veil upon his face again, until he went in to speak with him.
