Clear evidence for the verb and noun outside bibl. and eccl. writings appears to be wanting: cf. Anz Subsidia, p. 374 f. The suffix -άζειν was as active as our -fy in producing new words, and the abstract -ασμός accompanied it, as -fication accompanies our verb. When therefore άχιος was appropriated in Jewish circles to represent their special idea of "holiness," it was natural that the factitive derivative should be coined from it, as a technical term which would be immediately understood by any Greek, even if he had never met with the actual form. The series was the more needed, as Greek religion had already the forms άγιζω, άγιστείω, άγιστείω, άγιστείω, άγιστείω, έχιστείος, etc., with their technical meanings: the variant words with the added -α- answered to them in function, but were free from pagan association.

have kept the verb and the adjective closely connected.

Note this interesting comment. It would seem that <u>ayιά ζω</u> (haqiazō), "to-make-holy" is special for God's use.

Note first the uses in the N.T. that have an O.T. connection. Jesus taught the Jews how to pray. God's name is Jehovah.

Malachi 3 ASV

16 Then they that feared Jehovah spake one with another; and Jehovah "hearkened, and heard, and a "book of remembrance was written before him, for them that feared Jehovah, and that thought upon his name.

This is a prayer for the millennium. At the present the Jews do not use the name Jehovah and the KJ has almost totally eliminated God's name from the Bible. (6,000 mistakes)

Things are holy because of contact with God and his holiness.

Every creature of God may be used for food, "for the (ones) trusting and having-come-to-know---the truth thoroughly" because it is made holy through the word and intercession.

I TIMOTHY 4 CT

3 Hindering to-be-marrying, to-be-holding-off-for-themselves of-foods, which the God created with-reference-topartaking with giving-of-thanks for-the *ones* trusting and having-come-to-know-and-still-knowing the truth thoroughly.

4 Because every creature of-God is fine, and not-one-thing being-taken with giving-of thanks cast-away; 5 For it-is-being-made-holy through the word of-God and

Do not confuse beingmade-holy with salvation. Holiness stems from God. See again p.1 Matt. 23

Consider Peter's order to Jewish-Christians concerning being holy, aylos (hagios) used 228 times. The same command is extended to Gentiles as well. (2 Tim. 2:21, Rev. 22:11)

II TIMOTHY 2 CT

19 However the solid foundation of-the God has-stood-and-still-stands, having this seal: Jehovah came-to-know the *ones* being of-him, and: Let every *one*, the *one* naming the name of Jehovah, depart from unrighteousness.
20 But in a great house there-are not only vessels made-of-gold and made-of-silver, BUT also made-of-wood and made-of-clay, and *some*-which on-the-one-hand *are* with-reference-to honor, *some*-which on-the-other-hand *are* with-reference-to dishonor;

21 If therefore someone might-purge-out himself from these, he-will-be a vessel with-reference-to honor, having-been-and-still-made-holy, very-useful for-the despot, having-been-and-still-prepared with-reference-to every good work.

I believe holiness can only be achieved on a more permanent basis, in the Messiah, and in the Holy Spirit.

23 But may the God of-the peace himself make YOU holy entirely-perfect, and may YOUR entire spirit and soul and body be-kept faultlessly in the presence of-our Lord Jesus Messiah.

ACTS 26 CT

Remember this book is to Hebrews, not Gentiles. Animal sacrifices made Jews holy as to the flesh. (Heb. 9:13 p. 2) Jesus fulfilled these "shadows" to-make-holy the people, Israel. (Heb. 13:12p2) Also reread Heb. 2:11 p.2. The warning in Heb. 10:29, p.3 also states: " --- the blood of-the covenant, in-which he-was-made-holy --- " Heb. 10:10 and 14 confirm these other verses. See Apologetics 26 for the two parts to Israel.

1 Peter is also to Jews, not Gentiles; this time L Jewish-Christians. The Jews had made God's name Jehovah, so"holy" they refused to speak it. As "Christians" they are to make-holy Jehovah the Messiah" that is Jesus, in their hearts, not minds.

Paul never turned from Jews as some teach. See Acts 18:6 where Paul gave the message to Jews first and upon their rejection he went to the Gentiles in that place. But see Acts 18:18,19. Note here in Acts 26:17 Jesus sent Paul to "the people" (Israel) and the Gentiles; to bring people to trust in Jesus and thus join others "havingbeen-made-holy."
