7 For nation will-be-raised over nation and kingdom over kingdom; and famines and pestilences and earthquakes will-be according-to places.

8 But all these-things are beginning of-birth-pains.

# MARK 13 CT

7 But at-the-time-that <u>YOU-might-hear wars and reports</u> of-wars, YOU-be not being-alarmed; for it-is-essential to-come-to-pass, BUT not-yet the finish.

8 For nation will-be-raised upon nation and kingdom upon kingdom; and earthquakes will-be according-to places, and there-will-be famines and disturbances. These-things are beginnings of-birth-pains.

### UKE 21 CT

9 But at-the-time-that <u>YOU-might-hear-of wars</u> and instabilities might-YOU not be-terrified; for it-is-essential these-things to-come-to-pass first, BUT not immediately the finish.

10 Then he-was-saying to-them, Nation will-be-raised over nation and kingdom over kingdom;

11 Both great earthquakes according-to places and will-be famines and pestilences, both great fearful-things and signs will-be from heaven.

War is usually open and declared armed hostile conflict between states or nations and usually goes on for some time. A fight or battle is short and usually many fights or battles occur during a war.

The noun μάχη (fight) and the verb μάχομαι (to-fight) should not be mixed up with πόλεμος (war) and πολεμέω (to-war). [See μάχαιρα]

In Matt. 24:6, Mark 13:7, and Luke 21:9 we have Jesus' prophecy of wars. Wars take time, so there is no way anyone should have expected any imminent return of Jesus to establish his Kingdom. In all three of these passages a new Kind of upheaval is promised. (Matt. 6:7, Mark 13:8, Luke 21:10) I believe this to be a reference to World Wars I and II. (See Apologetics # 14) These wars were the beginning of Israel's "birth-pains"

#### C LUKE 14 CT

31 Or what king proceeding to-cast-together with-a-different king into a war, having-been-seated he-is NOT first resolving if he-is powerful with ten thousands to-meet with-the-one coming upon him with twenty thousands?

#### C I CORINTHIANS 14 CT

8 For also if a trumpet might-give an uncertain noise, who will-make-himself-ready with-reference-to a war?

#### HEBREWS 11 CT

34 They-extinguished-power of-fire, they-fled mouths ofa-dagger, they-were-made-powerful from weakness, theybecame-strong in war, they-reclined encampments belonging-to-others.

#### JAMES 4 CT

1 From-whence are wars and from-whence are fights among YOU? Are-they not hence out-of YOUR pleasures namely-the ones serving-in-the-army in YOUR members?

2 YOU-are-desiring, and YOU-are not having; YOU-are-murdering and YOU-are-being-jealous, and YOU-are not being-able to-attain; YOU-are-fighting and <u>YOU-are-waring</u>; YOU-are not having because YOU *are* not to-be-asking-for-yourself.

#### REVELATION 2 CT

16 You-repent therefore; but if not, I-am-coming to-you speedily and <u>I-shall-war</u> with them in the sword of my mouth.

### REVELATION 9 CT

7 And the similitudes of-the locusts like to-horses havingbeen-and-still-prepared with-reference-to war, and on their heads as crowns like to-gold, and their faces as faces of-MEN,

#### REVELATION 11 CT

A long term conflict.

The KJ in I Cor. 14:8

changes to "hattle", but

the Greek text is not

changed.

In Heb. 11:34 the KJ
changes to "fight", but
note Josephus' title,
"The Wars of the Jews".
These were long term
conflicts.

Here "fights" and wars are in the same verse, and "fighting" and "waring" are in the same verse; which indicates war" still refers to a long term conflict.

Remember James is to the 12 tribes. (Ja. 1:1)

This is to the Pergamos assembly. The Roman Catholic Church begins to come to power and a long term war begins. (See Revelation Translation and Commentary Vol. 1)

to "battle". In making any study of these very difficult and figurative passages the word "war" is important because it implies a conflict taking considerable time. When were or are or will-be these wars?

## REVELATION 13 CT

4 And they-worshipped the dragon, because he-gave the authority to-the beast, and they-worshipped the beast saying: Who is like to-the beast and who is-being-able to-war with it?

5 And a mouth was-given to-it speaking great-things and blasphemies, and authority was-given to-it to-do forty two months.

6 And it-opened its mouth with-reference-to blasphemies toward the God, to-blaspheme his name and his tabernacle and the *ones* tabernacling in the heaven.

7 And it-was-given to-it to-make war with the holy-ones and to-have-victory-over them, and authority was-given to-it over every tribe and people and language and nation.

#### REVELATION 16 CT

14 For they-are spirits of-little-demons, doing signs, to-be-proceeding-out over the kings of-the total inhabited-earth, to-gather them together with-reference-to the war of-the day, namely-the great day of-the God, namely-the Almighty.

#### REVELATION 17 CT

14 These will-war with the Lamb and the Lamb will-have-victory-over them because he-is Jehovah of-lords and King of-kings, and the *ones* with him are called *ones* and chosen *ones* and trustworthy *ones*.

#### REVELATION 19 CT

11 And I-saw the heaven having-been-and-still-opened, and behold, *a* white horse, and the *one* sitting on it being-called trustworthy and authentic, and in justice he-is-judging and <u>he-is-warring</u>.

## REVELATION 19 CT

19 And I-saw the beast, and the kings of-the earth, and their armies, having-been-and-still-gathered-together tomake the war with the *one* sitting on the horse and with his army.

#### REVELATION 20 CT

8 And he-shall-come-out to-lead-astray the Gentiles, namely-the-ones in the four corners of-the earth, to-lead-astray the Gog and the Magog, to-lead them together into the war, of-whom the number is as the sand of-the sea.

## Ezekiel 37 ASV

We need to learn a great deal but remember one thing, a "war" is not a "fight" or "battle", it takes time.
