Also: "wrath is anger remaining within." We will list all the uses in the NT, but not in the Biblical order.

EPHESIANS 4 CT

31 Let all bitterness and anger and wrath and clamor and blasphemy be-lifted-up from YOU with all malice.

COLOSSIANS 3 CT

8 But at-this-instant YOU yourselves place-off even all the things; wrath, anger, malice, blasphemy, shameful-speech out-of YOUR mouth;

I TIMOTHY 2 CT

8 I-am-purposing therefore the men to-be-praying in every place elevating hallowed hands separate-from wrath and deliberation.

JAMES 1 CT

19 YOU-are-knowing-absolutely my cherished brothers; but let every MAN be speedy with-reference-to, to-hear, slow with-reference-to, to-speak, slow with-reference-to wrath;

20 For wrath of-man is not working justice of-God.

Note, "wrath of-man".

We find another proof of the deity of Jesus. Jesus being God, and knowing all things, can justly exhibit "wrath."

Not "anger" as KJ.

5 But according-to your hardness and unrepentant heart you-are-storing for-yourself wrath in a day of-wrath and of-uncovering of-just-judgement of-the God,

6 Who will-give-back to-each one according-to his works: 7 On-the-one-hand to-the ones according-to perseverance of-good work seeking glory and honor and imperishability, life eternal;

8 On-the-other-hand to-the ones out-of ambitious-rivalry and disobeying the truth but relying on-the unrighteous-

ness, wrath and anger.

I THESSALONIANS 5 CT

9 Because the God has not placed us for-himself with-reference-to wrath BUT with-reference-to possession of-salvation through our Lord Jesus Messiah,

€ God's wrath was on Israel in the wilderness. God requires obedience. ((ev Th opyh mou," in the wrath of-me. In both Heb. 3:11 and Heb. 4:3)

The law establishes a line. Crossing the line is a Transgression.

All of these following passages on this page have no articles before "wrath". Those who are doing the wills of the flesh are by. nature children of-wrath. A day of wrath lies in their future, as well as a just-judgement of God. In 1 Thes. 5:9 we are told that those God placed, "with-referenceto possession of salvation through our Lord Jesus Messiah are not placed withreference-to wrath. This verse begins to lead into some very difficult theology. (See Predestination, and Saved by R.H. Mount)

JOHN 3 CT

36 The one trusting with-reference-to the son is-having life eternal; but the one disobeying to-the son will not see life. BUT the wrath of-the God is-remaining on him.

ROMANS 9 CT

22 But if the God willing to-demonstrate the wrath and to-make-known the possible intention of-him brought in much patience vessels of-wrath having-been-and-still-rendered-thoroughly-fit with-reference-to destruction, 23 And in-order-that he-might-make-known the riches of his glory on vessels of-mercy, which he-prepared-before with-reference-to glory,

24 Whom has he-called, even us, not only out-of Jews BUT also out-of nations?

LUKE 21 CT

36 He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him.

What will God's final wrath be like? Study the centuries of the sufferings of the Jews and consider the number of the Gentiles and pack the suffering into only a few years. (See the Romans Comm. by Mount) VS. 20 fulfilled AD. 66 vs. 23 wrath on Israel. Vs. 24 a. fulfilled AD. 70 V5.24 b. fulfilled during 1900 years of history. This prophecy by Jesus is unknown by most Christians. (See Times of Gentiles, by R.H. Mount and The National Geographic Magazine, Dec. 1967) It is amazing that those who talk of the Lord's soon return, ignore this fulfilled prophecy. God's soon coming

God's soon coming wrath is explained in the following verses.

I THESSALONIANS 2 CT

14 For YOU yourselves were-become imitators, brothers, of-the assemblies of-the God namely-the ones being in the Judea in Messiah Jesus, because YOU yourselves also suffered the same-things by your own fellow-countrymen, according-as also they by the Jews,

15 Even the ones having-killed the Lord Jesus and the prophets, and having-banished us, and not pleasing God,

and of ones contrary to-all MEN,

16 Hindering us to-speak to-the Gentiles in-order-that they-might-be-saved, with-reference-to-fill-up their sins always. But the wrath came-first on them with-referenceto a finish.

MATTHEW 3 CT

7 But having-seen many of-the Pharisees and Sadducees coming upon his baptism, he-said to-them, Products of-vipers, who indicated to-YOU to-flee from the future wrath?

LUKE 3 CT

7 Therefore he-is-saying to-the crowds proceeding-out to-be-baptized by him, Products of-vipers, who indicated to-YOU to-flee from the future wrath?

ROMANS 3 CT

5 But if our unrighteousness is commending the justice of-God, what shall-we-say? The God namely-the one bringing-on the wrath is unrighteous? I-am-saying according-to MAN.

ROMANS 12 CT

19 Not avenging yourselves, cherished ones, BUT YOUgive place to-the wrath; for it-has-been-and still-is-written: An-avenging is for me. I myself-shall-repay, Jehovah is-saying.

EPHESIANS 5 CT

5 For this YOU-are coming-to-know, that every maleprostitute or unclean man or covetous man, who-is an idolater, he-is not having inheritance in the kingdom ofthe Messiah and God.

I THESSALONIANS 1 CT

10 And to-be-awaiting his son out-of the heavens, whom he-raised out-of the dead ones, Jesus the one delivering us out-of the wrath namely-the coming.

The Jews were dividing into two groups; the ones receiving Jesus as the Messiah, as Paul, and those opposed. (See Apologetics #7) Under the Romans, God's wrath began to fall on His rebellious people.

We have two records of John the Baptist's warn-I ing of "the future wrath". Why did God bring-on the wrath? Rom. 3:5 says that he did. The Roman destruction of the temple, and Jerusalem, was really brought about by the Jews themselves. Without the Jews being dispersed, and vet remaining a separate people, the major proof that the Bible is God's Word would be missing. Note the words avenging. (See page I again,

vengeance or revenge, within the meaning of wrath.) "YOU-give place to-the wrath - God's wrath. "The wrath of-the God is-coming on the sons of-the disobedience. Eph. 5:6 and Col. 3:6

The true believers are being delivered outof the wrath namelythe coming.

ROMANS 5 CT

9 Therefore by-much more, having-been-justified now in his blood we-shall-be-saved from the wrath through him.

REVELATION 6 CT

16 And they-are-saying to-the mountains and to-the rocks: YOU-fall on us and YOU-hide us from the face of-the one sitting on the throne and from the wrath of-the Lamb, 17 Because the day, namely-the great day of-his wrath, came and who is-able to-be-stood?

REVELATION 11 CT

18 And the Gentiles were-made-wroth, and your wrath came and the season of-the dead to-be-judged and to-give the reward to-your slaves namely-the prophets and to-the holy ones and to-the ones fearing your name, the little ones and the great ones, and to-corrupt-through the ones corrupting-through the earth.

REVELATION 14 CT

10 Even he himself-will-drink out-of the wine of-the anger of-the God <u>namely-the wine having-been-and-still-mingled undiluted in the cup of-his wrath</u>, and he-will-be-tormented in fire and sulphur in-sight of-holy angels and in-sight of-the Lamb.

REVELATION 16 CT

19 And the city namely-the great one became into three parts, and the cities of the Gentiles fell. And Babylon the great was-remembered in-sight of the God to-give to-her the cup of the wine namely-of the anger of his wrath.

REVELATION 19 CT

15 And out-of his mouth a sharp sword is-proceeding-out, in-order-that with it he-might-smite the Gentiles; and he himself will-shepherd them with a rod of-iron; and he himself is-treading the wine-press of-the wine, namely-of-the anger, and of-the wrath of-the God namely-the Almighty.

* ROMANS 13 CT

3 For the rulers are not a fear to-the good work BUT to-the bad. But are-you-willing to-be not fearing the authority? You-be-doing the good-thing and you-will-have laudation out-of it;

4 For he-is a minister of-God to-you with-reference-to the good-thing. But if you-might-be-doing the bad-thing, of-fear; for he-is not wearing the dagger at-random; for he-is a minister of-God, an avenger with-reference-to wrath to-the one practicing the bad-thing.

5 On-this-account *it-is-a* necessity to-be-subjecting oneself, <u>not only because-of the wrath</u> BUT also because-of the conscience. "We-shall-be-saved from (away-from) the wrath."

The Living Bible

13 OBEY THE GOVERNMENT, for God is the one who has put it there. There is no government anywhere that God has not placed in power. 2 So those who refuse to obey the laws of the land are refusing to obey God, and punishment will follow. 1 For the policeman does not frighten people who are doing right; but those doing evil will always fear him. So if you don't want to be afraid, keep the laws and you will get along well. 'The policeman is sent by God to help you. But if you are doing something wrong, of course you should be afraid, for he will have you punished. He is sent by God for that very purpose. 'Obey the laws, then, for two reasons: first, to keep from being punished, and second, just because you know you should.

Such distortion of scripture is inexcusable. (Underlining is mine)
